Lawn Care Manager

Job Description:

Supervise, direct, and develop 1-3 team members, that perform lawn/turf and landscape bed management using spray and injection tools for residential and or commercial clients. Work closely with the supervisors to ensure scheduled jobs are completed each day and that client needs and expectations are met.

Qualifications:

- Registered Technicians Certification (*Required*). 3A or 3B Applicator License (*Preferred*).
- Ability to perform and train others in operating and performing lawn care services, with a positive and teachable attitude.
- 2 years' experience providing lawn care services for residential and or commercial clients in a supervisory position.
- Valid driver's license with clean driving record and ability to drive with trailer.
- Solid knowledge of turf care, identification of common weeds, insects, turf diseases, lawn care products, and application methods and procedures.
- Experience operating, cleaning, and maintaining lawn care equipment.
- Ability to mix/ measure and apply lawn care products at recommended rates according to product label.
- Ability to communicate and relate to customers in a friendly, respectful, and professional manner.

Responsibilities:

- Manage your crew's assigned routes, delegate work and supervise progress, to ensure sufficient resources and materials are available, and jobs are completed in an efficient manner.
- Communicate job status & updates with supervisors. Complete and deliver necessary paperwork.
- Maintain inventory of materials, equipment and other supplies are on hand to complete scheduled jobs.
- Help develop and train crew member(s). Assess and evaluate their performance strengths & weaknesses. Provide constructive feedback on crew member(s) to managers to improve your team.
- Provide lawn aeration, seeding, and turf management, utilizing personal protective equipment according to state law. Keep accurate records of lawn care product applications for each property.
- Clean, calibrate and perform preventative maintenance on equipment. Conduct weekly inspections.
- Monitor lawn health and care during and after applications and communicate progress to clients and supervisors. Educate clients on the diagnosis and prescribed pest control & fertilization services.
- Perform onsite evaluations of property. Identifying weeds & pests and implement appropriate control solutions. Promote and participate in sales opportunities with existing and perspective clients.

Staff Expectations:

- Be on time and have flexibility in work schedule. 7:30 AM – 4:30 PM, Monday – Friday. Saturdays mandatory during peak season.
- Work and communicate in a team environment in the field.
- Follow all safety guidelines and ensure crew members are also abiding by these protocols. Notify supervisors of any broken equipment or potential hazards.
- Load and unload equipment daily. Return any equipment to where you found it. Keep work truck clean and organized.
